

Diss Infant and Nursery School with Children's Centre
Educational Visit to the Museum of East Anglian Life in
Stowmarket



We have arranged an educational visit for Year 2 children to the Museum of East Anglian Life in Stowmarket on Tuesday 7th November 2017.

The children will be travelling on a coach fitted with seatbelts and will be leaving school at 9.00am, returning to school by 3pm. A risk assessment has been carried out for this activity and your children will be supervised throughout to a ratio of at least 1:6 plus an additional adult.

We are aware of children with medical conditions as notified by parents and all inhalers and a full medical bag will be carried with us.

Your child will need:

- To wear school uniform
- Sensible shoes
- All children will need a packed lunch (no fizzy drinks, glass bottles or chocolate please) and sufficient water for the day. **(A school packed lunch can be ordered – please see bottom of consent form attached)**
- A waterproof coat

In order for this visit to take place, it is necessary to ask for a voluntary contribution of £10.50 per child, which includes entry to the museum, an educational workshop – ‘Life in the Past: Meet the Finch family’ and coach travel. If contributions do not cover the cost, then unfortunately the visit will not be able to go ahead.

PLEASE RETURN THE ATTACHED CONSENT FORM TOGETHER WITH PAYMENT IN A NAMED, SEALED ENVELOPE AND GIVE TO YOUR CHILD'S CLASS TEACHER BY **WEDNESDAY 1ST NOVEMBER.**

IF CHANGE IS REQUIRED THIS WILL BE BROUGHT HOME IN AN ENVELOPE WITH YOUR CHILD ONCE ADMINISTRATION HAS TAKEN PLACE.

Please note – children for whom permission slips have not been returned or those who do have not appropriate clothing and shoes will have to remain in school. We are unable to continue to remind parents once notice has been given.

Parents in receipt of income support, or those who would find it difficult to enclose a contribution please discuss the remission of charges with Mrs Schug. If you are unable to make a contribution, the right of your child to take part in the visit will not be affected.
